

Beresford High School General Registration Information

Birth Certificate: SDCL 13-27-3.1 requires the parent or legal guardian to provide the school with a certified copy of the student's birth certificate within 30 days of initial enrollment.

Immunization Records: A copy of your child's immunization records must be provided to the school upon enrollment.

School Website: The Beresford School District's website is <http://www.beresford.k12.sd.us>. This website contains information including the school calendar, medication forms, the school newsletter, menus and other important items. There is also a link to the Beresford High School web page; here you will find information about course registration, a list of staff with email addresses, class schedules, the student handbook, student announcements and other items of interest. Links for the iPad consent forms and beginning-of-the-year forms can also be found here. The website is updated on a daily basis so new information is posted as it becomes available.

iPads: iPads will be distributed each fall during iPad Orientation. Parents and students must sign and return copies of the *iPad Protection Plan*, *Student Pledge*, and *Acceptable Use Policy* documents before the iPad can be issued. The iPad Protection Plan outlines the requirements for obtaining the iPad. These forms can be found on the BHS web page.

Student Fees: A \$30 student fee is required. This fee includes \$25 for iPad protection and \$5 for class dues.

Student Athletic Pass: Student athletic passes are available to all students for \$20.00. This pass is good for admission to all regular scheduled home athletic events. Passes are available at the office.

Student Physicals: Students must have a yearly sports physical prior to participating in athletics. Physical forms are available on-line or upon request.

Attendance: High School begins at 8:17 a.m. and dismisses at 3:17 p.m. If your child is absent from school for any reason, please call the school office before school starts. Please notify the office in advance if your child has an appointment during school hours. Students must check in and out through the High School Office if they come after the regular start time or leave before dismissal. Food Service: Payments for meals should be made in the school office before school. Students will be given a verbal reminder and/or an email when their lunch accounts have a low or negative balance and account balances are available online via the Parent Portal. All extras are sold only after the purchase of a nutritional meal. However, students may purchase milk without first purchasing a meal. Applications for free or reduced-price lunches are available upon request. Menus are posted on the school's website.

Parent Portal: Parent Portal is an on-line tool used to monitor your child's progress. You may view report cards, grades, missing assignments, attendance, schedules, behavior issues and make lunch account payments. Health Concerns: Please notify the school nurse if your child has a health condition. We do have pain reliever (acetaminophen or ibuprofen) available to students who have a signed consent form on file. Over-the-counter and prescription medications should be given to students outside of school hours if possible. Please contact the school nurse if prescription medication must be given during school hours.
